Final Pavement Marking KANJ-Sanderson Field

Continued Improvements at Sanderson Field

Sault Ste. Marie, MI - Airport users as well as the general public are being made aware that the runway at the City's municipal airport will be closed tomorrow, Tuesday, September 26th, starting at 7 am until the pavement marking is finished.

"We anticipate that the runway will reopen late Tuesday, pending any rain., "reported EDC Executive Director Jeff Holt. "We are very happy to see the final runway completed and the pilots have been raving about the final product."

During the month of August, Sanderson Field was closed in order to put down a porous friction overlay (PFC Overlay) course, which is anticipated to rejuvenate the life of the runway for 10-15 years. This material has been used at other Michigan airports with noted success in Cadillac, Sturgis and Bellaire. Additional improvements associated with the project will be new paint and improved drainage which will decrease hydroplaning.
